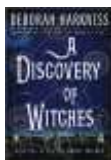

**Friday, December 23<sup>rd</sup>**

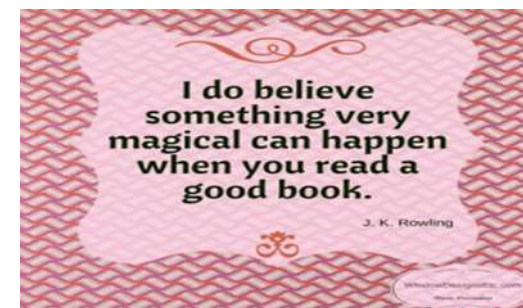
