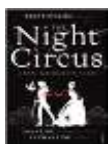
Immunizations

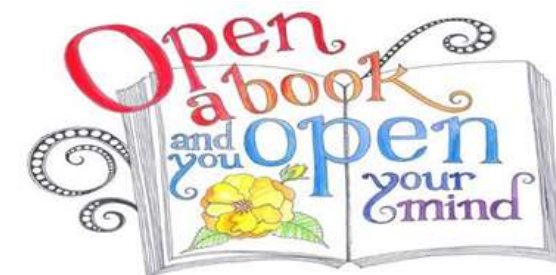
