We are making some changes and we apologize for any inconvenience it may cause you. As we start moving books around and

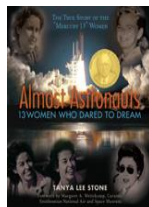

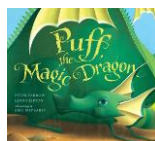

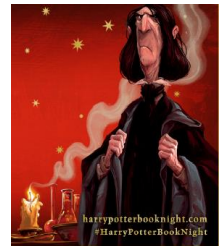
