Library Closure

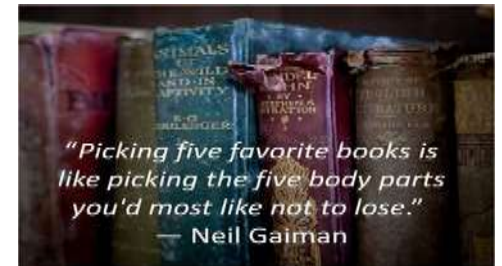
Library closed on **Monday, September 4th for Labor Day**. The library will reopen on **Tuesday, September 5th at 10 am**.

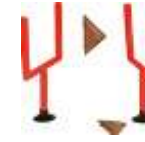
International Talk Like a Pirate Day
