Multiple sales continue at the Book Corner. All small paperback books, cookbooks, and games are half price. Inventory is up, so your selection of items to choose from will be numerous!

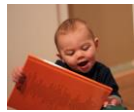

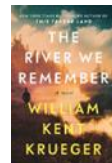
