Story Time is taking a break for the month of August. Baby Story Time will be back September 4th and September 7th for Story Hour!

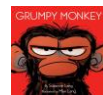

Thurs., August 2nd Starting at 1pm join us for **Water Wars!**

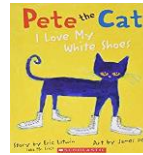
