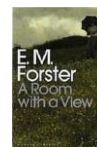
## Adult Book Clubs!

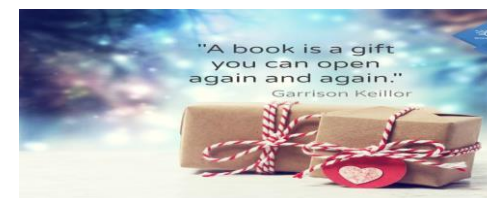

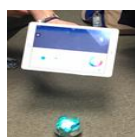
## Yarn Exchange –December 2<sup>nd</sup>
