Thursday, June 25th: Are you ready to dance?! Come dance to DDR (Dance Dance Revolution) at **12:30-2 pm**.

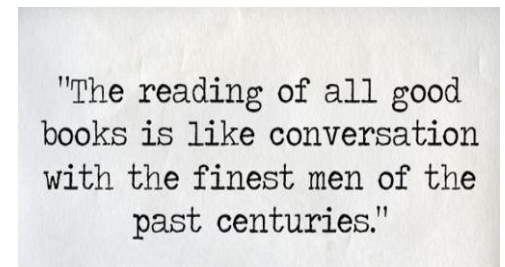

Internet hour is held on the **second Tuesday** of each month from **11 am- 12 pm** for those with questions about email, browsing the internet and more.



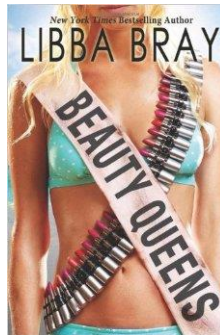
Brewer Reading Challenge
