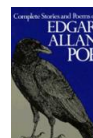

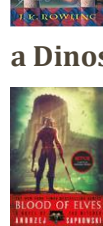
Book Worms: Current read is your choice on **Tues. May 19th at 5 pm** via email or Zoom. Please email us for an invitation to discuss your book.

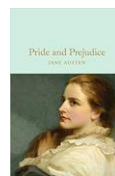

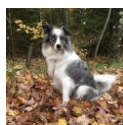
