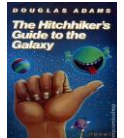

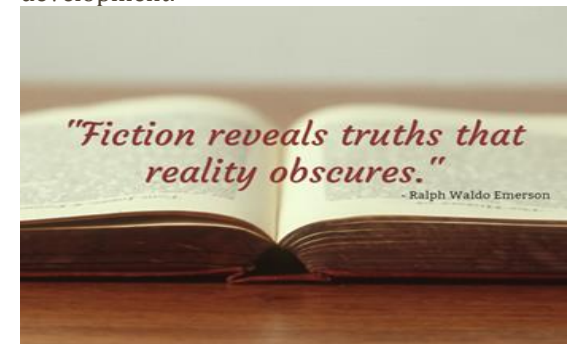
Let's Get Cooking
