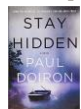

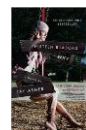

## New Roof

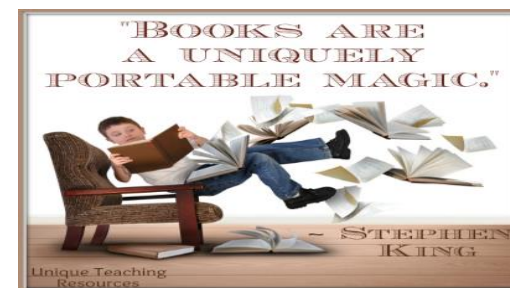
We recently got our roof redone. We are so happy to have our roof fixed. Stop by the library to check it out!
